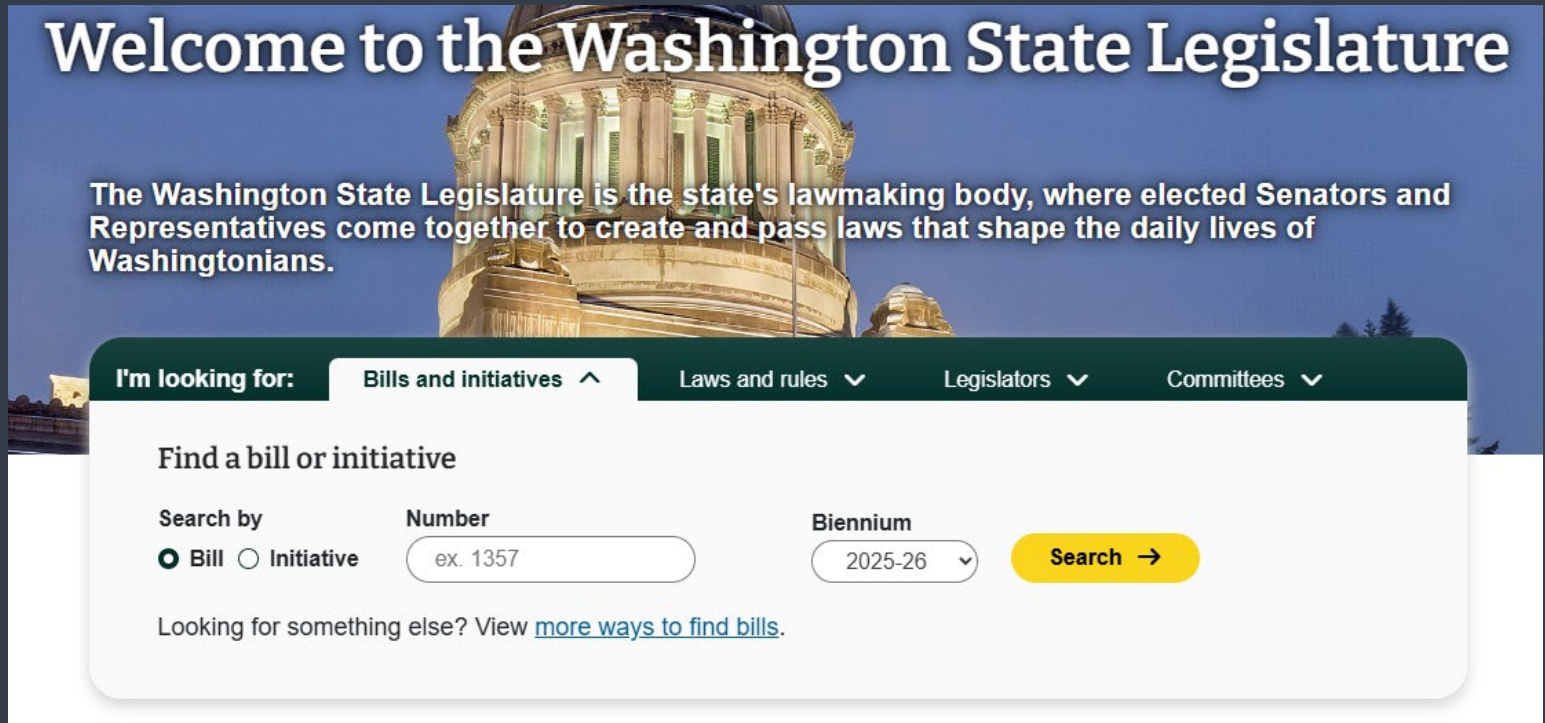

Legitron Suggestions

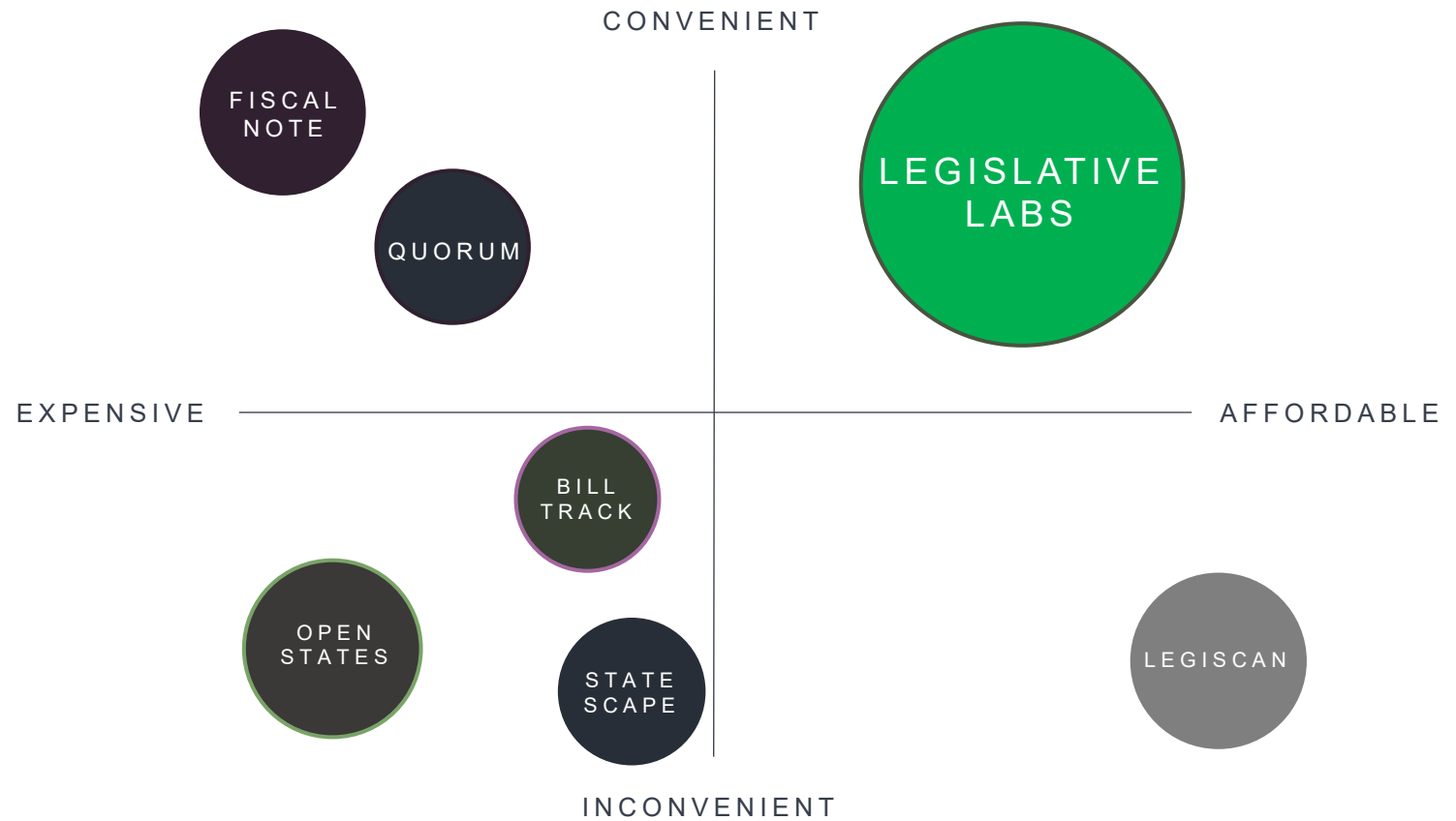
